The Simon Companies (property management company) of Braintree contracted with Associate Roofing to evaluate the roof condition and draw up a replacement plan for the Mayflower Village in Plymouth, MA. The Mayflower complex is a multi-housing project consisting of some 25 buildings. Following Michael Lynch's evaluation and recommendation, the owners hired Associate Roofing to replace the entire 120,000 square feet of shingles. The project included shingle replacement of all 25 buildings. In addition to finishing the job within budget, the crew successfully fulfilled the contract 30 days early.


